COVID-19 social distance measures

Amended Playground Operations

- Playgrounds will operate a maximum capacity of 32 people (children and adults). Not including staff numbers.
- The playground service will be operating at a reduced timetable.
 - After school sessions 16:00-18:00.
 - Summer holiday sessions 09:30 – 12:30 and 13:30 – 16:30.
- There will be a 1 HOUR time limit per play session.
- The cabins will be closed for indoor play.
- Toilet facilities will be open where possible.
- Some swings to be removed to enable continued use.
- Hand sanitiser stations will be placed around playground.
- Signage will be placed around playground reminding of social distancing and hand cleaning requirements.
- Equipment will be cleaned regularly. Morning and afternoon with certain equipment after every use.
- Staff will limit numbers of users allowed on pieces of equipment.
- Shop to operate through the external service hatches with social distancing markers for queuing. Only pre-packed food to be sold, no hot food.
- Waste bins to be emptied regularly.
- Visitors will be signed in and out of the playground by a member of staff.

Child and Parent Expectations

- Children under 11 must be supervised at all times by an appropriate adult regardless of age (one adult can supervise up to 4 children).
- All visitors will be required to use the sanitisers provided, upon entry and before the use of any equipment.
- Staff will provide instructions before entry to the playground – such as:
 - Avoid putting face on equipment and hands in mouths.
 - Visitors should avoid touching their eyes face and mouth, and follow good respiratory hygiene, covering your mouth and nose with a bent elbow or tissue following Catch it, Bin- it- Kill it.
 - Parent/career should bring hand sanitiser gel or wipes for personal hygiene measures.
 - All visitor must follow strict social distancing measures of 2 metres, visitors may be asked to leave if the guidance is not adhered to.
 - Please use the bins provided to dispose of hand wipes, tissues and PPE.
 - Visitors will be encouraged to practice good hand hygiene more often than usual using approved gel and foam sanitiser, particularly at the beginning and end of play.
- If people attending have clear symptoms of Covid-19 they will be refused entry and advised to follow Government guidelines.
